

Planting Guidelines


Before you plant, observe the location and the amount of sunlight.




Read Carefully the type of soil you are using.


Determine soil texture by feel or quart jar shake test.

When should you plant? Time of day matter?

What is the plants purpose in a particular spot?

Where is the correct placement?

How often do we impulse buy?

Common mistake – Planting too early in the season.

Types of Plant Propagation


Seeds - Cutting - Division

Definition – Plant Propagation is the process of creating new plants.









Cuttings

Make sure the cutting is at least 3 inches long.

Use a knife to cut the stem from a mature plant.



Remove the bottom few sets of leaves on the cutting.





Examples of Lavender, Rosemary, and Santolina cuttings.




Fill pot with compost or potting soil or your own mixture. Dip bottom of the stem in a rooting hormone and insert into the pot.



Propagation using Division Rudbeckia - common name is Black-eyed Susan And

Sedum - Common name Autumn Joy Sedum

Cuttings & Division FAQs

How often do you divide a plant?

What season is the best time to propagate?

Where do propagated plants through cutting or division have the best survival rate? In a pot or into the ground?

When and How to divide flowering spring bulbs and rhizomes?

Common mistake – Afraid to tear into or cut existing plants. (Thank you Dig-n-Divide Team on getting us over this one)
